During the winter the Winnipeg Sports Car Club organizes ice racing in and around Winnipeg and Gimli on frozen water bodies. The cars race on a closed ice track created by plowing snow down to the ice with snow banks defining the track edge. In 2015 the locations included:

- Mazonod Road retention pond, south of Dugald Road, Winnipeg, Manitoba
- Lake Shirley Water Ski Pond, Murdock Road, south of Dugald Road, Winnipeg, Manitoba
- Lake Winnipeg, opposite the Lakeview Inn in Gimli, Manitoba



WSCC Ice Racing Membership Renewal Process

For Ice Racing in Manitoba, here's how to renew your membership with WSCC then your race license with WCMA. Make sure you do this at least three weeks prior to your first race weekend. This separated up in to two areas: Step (A) is renewing your WSCC Membership and Step (B) is renewing your WCMA License:

Step #1) go to: <http://www.dlbracing.com/> and login via the login button with your DLBRacing account, if you do not have a DLBRacing account then set one up:



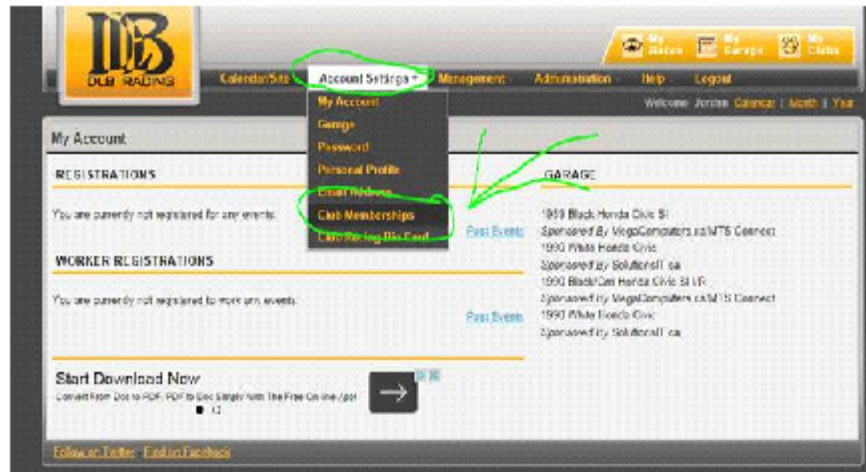

The Winnipeg Sports Car Club organizes autoslalom racing in and around Winnipeg. The track is laid out with orange traffic cones and cars run one at a time through the course competing for the best time in multiple classes.

The main location is the St. Andrews Airport just north of Winnipeg with events also held at the Red River Exhibition Park in Winnipeg and on the race track at the Gimli Motorsport Park in Gimli, Manitoba.

A race license is not required to compete in autoslalom making it one of the most accessible motorsports to participate in. The 2015 autoslalom results were:

How to Autoslalom

1. Renew through DLB

If you are interested in autocrossing with the WSCC this season, it's highly recommended to get an annual membership. You will get a \$10 discount for each autocross event. The annual membership dues are \$50. So you will get your money's worth if you plan on attending 5 or more autocross events in addition to all the other benefits of an annual WSCC membership.

To renew or apply for a new membership:

- Go to <http://www.dlbracing.com> and create an account or log in if you already have one.
- Choose "My Clubs" and search through the list for Winnipeg Sports Car Club.
- Fill out the application and make sure your info is accurate. It will need to match your MSR profile (see step 2).
- If you're a new member applying for the first time, you don't need to provide a member # as you haven't been assigned one yet.
- Pay your dues via PayPal.

2. Create a profile on MSR

WSCC Autoslalom division is now using a new event registration system for 2015, MotorsportReg (MSR). This system is widely used across North America by over 700 clubs, including the SCCA for Solo Nationals and Tour events.

You will need to create an account on MSR to register online for 2015 autocross events.

- Go to MotorsportReg.com and create an account.
- Please use the same email you used on your account on DLB. This same email will be used to contact you regarding event info.
- Please make sure your first and last name are spelled exactly as in DLB.
- Once you've created your account, join the WSCC as one of the clubs you're a member of. It should come up as a suggestion on your dashboard. Otherwise, you can find your club info under "My Account" and add it from there.
- When joining you will be asked to provide a member # if you have one. Otherwise, you can leave it blank.

3. Reserve a permanent number for the 2015 season

If you would like to reserve a permanent number for the 2015 season, follow the procedure in the 2015 permanent number thread.

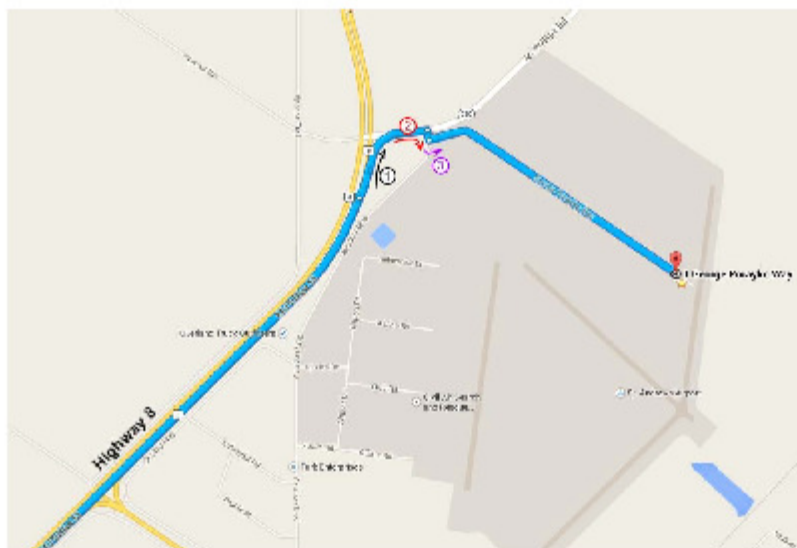
4. You're done! You can visit the website <http://wsc.motorsportreg.com> to view the calendar and register for future events.

While it's not necessary but it's highly advisable to do the above process ahead of the season. It can take up to a week for your membership info to be verified. This will ensure that any possible issues that may arise can be resolved in a timely manner.

Directions to the WSCC Autocross Venue at St. Andrews Airport



Drive North from Winnipeg on Highway 8

Highway 8 is also known as "McPhillips Street" while you're still in the city.

Drive 12.5 km / 8 min out of the city (North of the Perimeter Hwy)

1. Turn right off Hwy 8 onto McPhillips Rd / Hwy 230

Watch for road signs that say "McPhillips Rd" and "Selkirk" and Highway number "230."

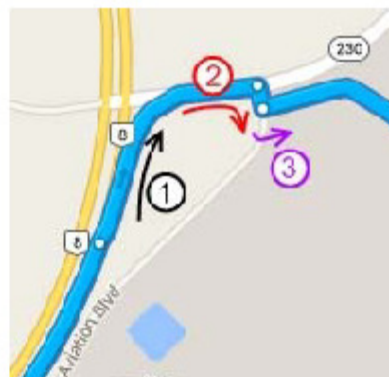
Continue for 450 m

2. Take the first right onto Aviation Blvd

Continue for 39 m

3. Take an immediate left onto George Porayko Way.

It is a low speed gravel road that drives past the airport tower. Follow it all the way to the end, where you will see orange cones that guide you into the grid area. Drive slowly on this road.

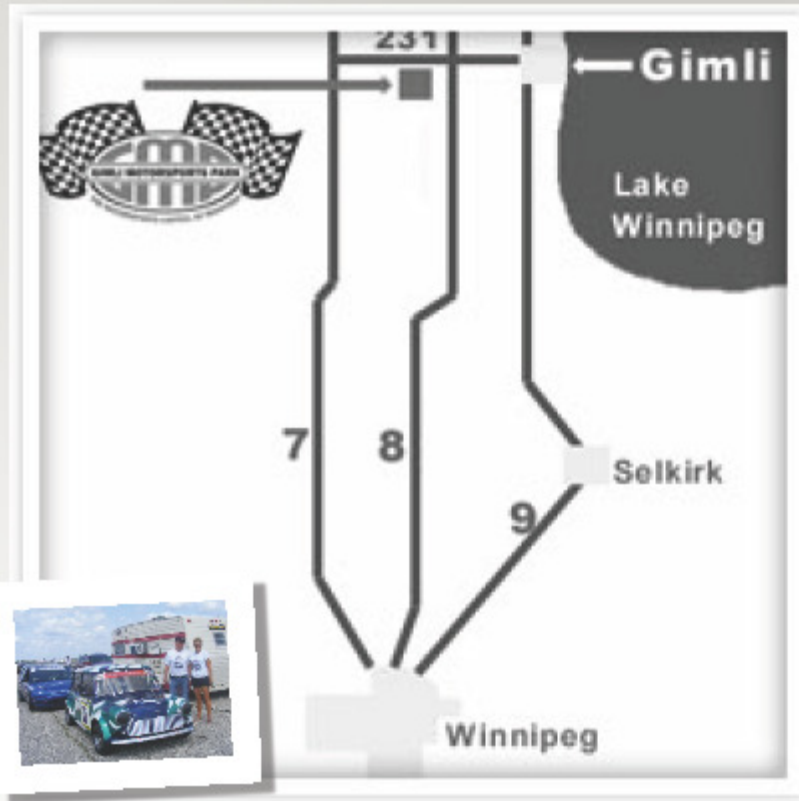

2015 Road Race Results

The Winnipeg Sports Car Club organizes road racing at the Gimli Motorsport Park in Gimli, Manitoba. The 1.3 mile (2.09km) race track consists of 8 or 9 corners (the last corner can be configured in two different layouts as one or two corners).

The racing includes multiple classes of fully prepared open and closed wheel race cars. Open wheel and closed wheel cars compete in separate races and street cars race on the track against the clock in Time Attack.

Both road racing and Time Attack require the driver to have the appropriate WCMA license (Amateur / Historic license for road racing, Basic license for Time Attack). To get licenses, the club holds a High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE) race school in May each year that includes classroom and race track sessions.

In 2015, the annual vintage weekend attracted cars and drivers from five provinces (B.C., Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Ontario) and two states (North Dakota and Minnesota).

2015 Time Attack Results

The Winnipeg Sports Car Club organizes Time Attack at the Gimli Motorsport Park race track in Gimli, Manitoba on the Saturdays of road race weekends.

In Time Attack, multiple cars compete on the track at the same time against the clock. The fastest lap times on a race weekend are often set by a driver during the Time Attack sessions.

Mostly newer street cars compete in Time Attack and as they do not require safety equipment, such as roll cages, passing is only allowed in designated areas and no wheel to wheel racing is allowed.

Time Attack requires the driver to have a WCMA Basic license that can be obtained by attending race school in May each year. The race school, or High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE), includes classroom and race track sessions.
